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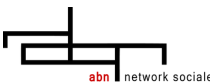

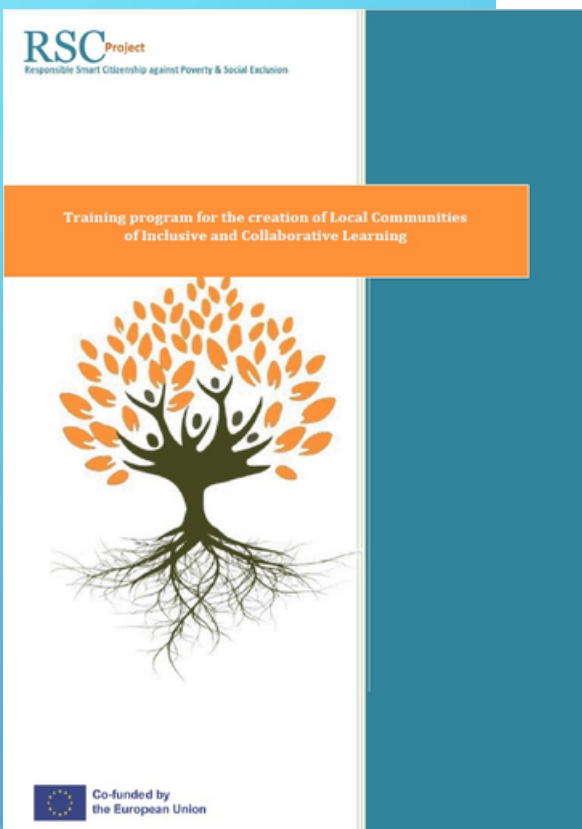

Newly Launched Courses

The consortium produced two courses that aim to upskill educators in the fight against poverty and social exclusion. These courses are designed to provide effective tools for creating local learning communities and developing projects that fight poverty and social exclusion.



Course 1:

Local Communities for Inclusive and Collaborative Learning

The course provides an in-depth understanding of community participation as a key strategy for community development. It offers techniques and methodologies to promote and develop participatory processes. The course is divided into six modules, each focusing on a different aspect of community participation.



Course 2:

Participatory Methodologies, Design & Evaluation for Trainers

The course is designed to equip trainers with methodologies and techniques that foster participatory processes, thereby promoting social inclusion and cohesion. The course is divided into eight modules, each focusing on a different aspect of participatory methodologies.

January 2023 Partner Meeting in Perugia

The consortium met in an informative meeting in Perugia, Italy, coordinating the project's digital components, training material developed and upcoming activities.

April to July 2023

KETHEA, **DOCUMENTA** and **Consorzio ABN** invite a group of experts to to analyse, and validate the two curricula developed. The input of experts will be pivotal in ensuring quality and usability from the intended audiences. The groups will be hosted and materialised in Greece, Spain and Italy.

August to December 2023

DOCUMENTA (Spain) and **Consorzio ABN** (Italy) invite a group of participants to join them in the online delivery of the project curriculum, guided by experienced educators and trainers.

KETHEA (Greece) invites a group of participants to take part in a Face-to-Face delivery of the project curriculum, guiding the participants around the created resources and material.

All participants from pilotings, F-2-F and online, will receive a **certificate of participation!**



September 2023 Partner Meeting in Cyprus

The consortium plans to hold a transnational partner meeting in Nicosia, Cyprus, in September 2023. There the four organizations will coordinate on the upcoming trainings and delivery of the material to beneficiaries.

Additionally, it will attempt to expand its reach at a local and European level, setting the ground for the development of the White Paper for Policy Advocacy against Poverty and Social Exclusion, which aims to encompass the lessons, suggestions and recommendations from our national and international efforts.
